CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and work within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with instructors.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in a Martial Art.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' and Instructors' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their Martial Art.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Leave the instructing to the Instructors.
- Parents/guardians and family members including younger siblings are welcome to sit in during the session provided they are quiet and do not distract the children from their training.
- Please make sure mobile phones are turned off or put on 'Silent' mode during the session.
